The Jaguar Kingdom, Birds & Mammals of Pantanal & Cerrado



## OVERVIEW

\* This Tour includes the best wildlife areas of Central Brazil, a combination of the Transpantaneira Road with a **Jaguar safari in Porto Jofre**, and the Brazilian Savanna in Chapada dos Guimarães/Nobres.

\* Chapada dos Guimarães National Park & Nobres protect a vast area of *Cerrado* (Brazilian Savanna) and its fauna. The Nat Park is home for the endangered Maned Wolf and also harbors a fine selection of endemic and range restricted birds. In Nobres, we go snorkeling with hundreds of neo-tropical fresh water fish, stingrayss and dwarf caimans.

\* This Tour targets an array of Macaw species and parrots including Red-and-Green Macaw, Hyacinth Macaw, Blue-and-Yellow Macaw, Red-bellied Macaw, Golden-collared Macaw and Blue-winged Macaw, besides close encounters with highlights including Ocelots, Tapirs, Anteaters, Giant Otters & Jaguars to mention but a few.

\* Boat, overland, walking and night safaris in search for dry-land mammals & birds.

# ITINERARY

**Day 1, 1st of August 2023**

**Cuiabá airport > Pouso Alegre Lodge**

Arrival at Cuiabá, where you'll meet your guide and transfer to the Pantanal. After about one and a half hour, we arrive in Poconé. From here, our adventure starts, as we hit the Transpantaneira, a dirt road that transects the Northern Pantanal. We will stop to photograph all kinds of wildlife on our way, and arrive at our lodge for lunch. Check-in and walk in the surroundings of the lodge. At night, we go out on a drive in search for nocturnal animals such as Ocelot, Puma, Giant Anteater, Tamandua, Crab-eating Raccoon, Potoos, and Owls. Dinner and Overnight. (L,D)

**Day 2, 2nd of August**

**Pouso Alegre Lodge**

Full day to enjoy the many wildlife opportunities at this private reserve. We will spend time photographing the Hyacinth Macaws, Toucans, Aracaris, and small mammals just by the lodge. We will also photograph Caimans, Jabirus and many other, along the lodge's 7km private road. Our activities are a combination of overland safari, forest walks and night safaris. We will discover the remote areas of this vast ranch, that stands as the best spot to find Tapirs & Anteaters in the Northern Pantanal, and often offers close encounters with other species such as Red-brocket and Marsh Deer, Coati, and Tayra. After dinner, safari in search of nocturnal wildlife. (B,L,D)

**Day 3, 3rd of August**

**Pouso Alegre Lodge > Porto Jofre**

Early morning walk & wildlife spotting at the feeder near the lodge. This morning we will climb up the 25m tower and enjoy the panoramic view of the Pantanal Wetlands.

Lunch and checkout. Driving further into the Pantanal, as we cover the Transpantaneira road to reach Porto Jofre and check-in at our lodge, located on the riverbank of the Cuiabá river in the late afternoon. We hope to see the Hyacinth Macaws, and other birds near the Giant Waterlilie lake. Dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

**Days 4&5, 4th & 5th of August 2023**

**Jaguar Boat Safaris in Porto Jofre**

Two days devoted to boat safaris on the Cuiabá river and its tributaries, in order to maximize our chances to watch and photograph Jaguars, Giant Otters and other wildlife in the Meeting of the Waters State Park. Outings in the morning and afternoon, cruising the rivers in search of Jaguars which come to the banks in search of food, water, or just to cool off. Dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

**Day 6, 6th of August**

**Porto Jofre > Piuval Lodge**

Breakfast, and last full morning of boat safari on the Cuiabá river and its tributaries. Lunch, check-out and overland safari along the Transpantaneira to the Piuval Lodge, arriving at lunch time. In the early evening, checkin. Dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

**Day 7, 7th of August**

**Piuval Lodge, Pantanal ranch**

Full day to explore the many wildlife opportunities on this 7,000 hectares private reserve. Our activities are a combination of overland safaris, forest walks and night safaris. Horseback riding optional. (B,L,D)

**Day 8, 8th of August**

**Piuval Lodge > Chapada dos Guimarães**

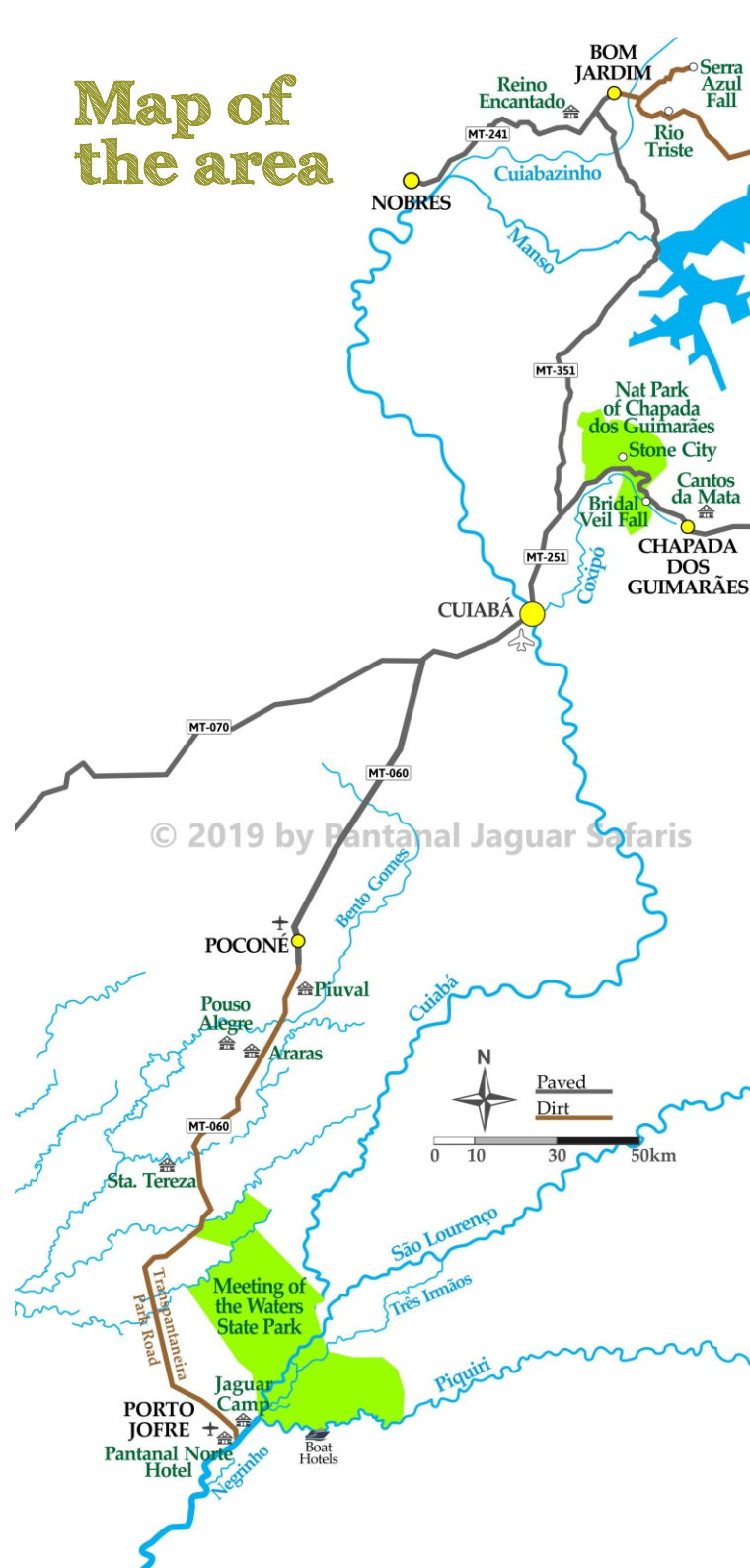
Full morning of activities to discover the wildlife opportunities. Lunch and check-out. This afternoon we will drive for about 3,5h on a good road to the cosy town of Chapada dos

## Day 9, 9th of August Chapada dos Guimarães, National Park

Early morning birding before breakfast. After breakfast we go into the National Park and visit the Bridal's Veil where we might be able to find and photograph Red-and-green Macaws. These giant birds nest on the rock faces along the canyons. We will have lunch in Chapada town and after lunch we head to *Cidade de Pedra*, the Stone City. Besides the great scenery, we might have the opportunity to watch and photograph the elusive Maned Wolf, Red-and-green Macaw, King Vulture, and more. (B,L,D)

## Day 10, 10th of August Chapada dos Guimarães > Nobres

After breakfast we check-out and drive to Bom Jardim, district of Nobres. We will arrive there around lunch time. After lunch we go snorkeling downstream the Rio Triste river. We will snorkel with hundreds of fresh water fish and stingrays, in crystalline waters. In the early evening we drive to the Macaw's lake to watch and photograph the Blue-and-yellow Macaws, Red-bellied Macaws, and many other birds that roost together for the night. (B,L,D)

## Day 11, 11th of August Nobres > Cuiabá airport

Breakfast, another full morning of birding and wildlife photography on the private trail of the lodge. Lunch and check-out, transfer to Cuiabá where we arrive in the afternoon. (B,L)
